TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST or T-SPOT BLOOD TEST

How is tuberculin skin testing done?

The tuberculin skin test (TST) is used to detect individuals with past tuberculosis (TB) infection, who now have diminished skin test reactivity. This procedure will reduce the likelihood that a boosted reaction is later interpreted as a new infection.

Visit 1: Place the 1st TST

Visit 2: Return in 48-72 hours for the test to be read.

FYI: We will accept 2 TB tests within the past year prior to class
