

# EMS Program Student Expectations

The EMS program is an adult orientated class. These classes prepare a person for either becoming an entry level EMT or furthering your education and becoming an Advanced EMT. The Basic EMT course is right around 300 hours total between all classroom time and clinical experience time. The AEMT course is right around 400 hours with classroom time and clinical experience time.

EMS program students will have the knowledge of and be able to complete the following expectations:

## **BASIC EMT**

- 1. Comply with all rules and policies as listed in the EMS Program Student Handbook**
- 2. Plan on spending at least 1-2 hours daily in studying, workbooks, quizzes.**
- 3. Have excellent time management skills.**
- 4. Come to class having ALL reading and homework assignments ready.**
- 5. Come to class with questions over the reading assignments.**
- 6. Pass ALL quizzes with an 80% average.**
- 7. Pass ALL Module exams with 80% or higher.**
- 8. Pass the class final exam with an 80% or higher.**
- 9. Pass the course with an 80% or higher.**
- 10. Complete the class workbook to at least 80% completion.**
- 11. Maintain 80% and higher for class attendance and participation.**
- 12. Complete all clinical time by the given deadline.**
- 13. Complete all skills testing with passing scores during the course and during the skills final exam.**

## **ADVANCED EMT**

- 2. Plan on spending at least 1-2 hours daily in studying, workbooks, quizzes.**
- 3. Have excellent time management skills.**
